TUESDAY 30 SEPTEMBER 2025 DEAKIN UNIVERSITY, BURWOOD **CAMPUS**

The final Masterclass of 2025 was a huge success! Hosted at the beautiful Deakin University Burwood Campus, bringing together 93 Skyline students for a day of learning, lots of laughter, and connection. The theme of the day was A.C.T on Your Future, encouraging students to explore how Academics, Confidence, and Teamwork & Leadership shape their next steps in education and beyond.

Each part of the program focused on one of these three pillars. Students began the day exploring academic pathways with Deakin mentors through interactive sessions like Map Your Future, Uni Myths Busted, and Level Up. Confidence took centre stage during the high-energy improv workshops with The Improv Conspiracy, where students learned the power of saying yes and embracing new challenges. The day wrapped up with a creative teamwork and leadership challenge hosted by Kristy, inspired by Brooklyn Nine-Nine, where students collaborated to solve a true-crime-style mystery.



A DAY OF ACADEMIC DISCOVERY HOSTED BY DEAKIN UNIVERSITY

Deakin University's mentors set the tone for the day, offering relatable insights and honest reflections on what it's really like to step into higher education. Their warmth and openness made each activity feel personal, helping students envision their own paths forward.

Map Your Future

The day began with Map Your Future, where students explored the many pathways into tertiary study. The session broke down complex ideas about course entry, scholarships, and study flexibility into real-world examples that made university feel achievable for everyone. Students gained clarity and confidence about how to shape their own academic journeys. Scavenger Hunt and Uni Myths Busted

Energy levels soared during the Deakin Campus Scavenger Hunt, as students teamed up to discover different corners of the university, chat with mentors, and see what campus life looks like up close. Afterward, the Uni Myths Busted workshop tackled common misconceptions about university life. Deakin students shared their lived experiences, showing that higher education is accessible to all who are curious and determined.

Level Up

To finish the Deakin-led sessions, Level Up encouraged students to take charge of their learning and wellbeing through strategies for motivation, balance, and goal setting. 
