# CELEBRATING OUR IMPACT IN 2023

IN THE PAST YEAR, SKYLINE EDUCATION FOUNDATION HAS REMAINED RESOLUTE IN ITS COMMITMENT TO EMPOWERING YOUNG PEOPLE, PROVIDING COMPREHENSIVE SUPPORT FOR THEIR ACADEMIC AND PERSONAL GROWTH. AS WE REFLECT ON THE ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE PAST YEAR, WE ARE PROUD TO SHARE THE IMPACT OF OUR PROGRAMS AND INITIATIVES.

#### IMPACT OF THE SKYLINE PROGRAM

In 2023, 78 of the 80 Skyline students who entered the Program in 2022 completed Year 12, marking a significant milestone in their academic journey. 96% of 2023 Year 12 survey respondents reported they believed the Skyline Program helped them develop skill they would not have otherwise developed, and 97% reported they were transitioning into their preferred pathway of choice after Year 12. This accomplishment is a testament to the dedication of our Skyline team, including our board, staff, alumni, donors and partners, in providing the necessary tools and support for students to thrive academically. 94% accepted offers from tertiary institutions and over a quarter of these students received scholarships. The top tertiary pathways were health sciences, science, arts and engineering. At Skyline we are incredibly proud of and humbled by the amazing students we get to work alongside – we hope to continue creating positive impacts on our students, their families and their communities to ultimately help break the cycle of educational inequity.

This positive feedback highlights the quality and effectiveness of our comprehensive educational experience.



### IMPACT OF SKYLINE HATCH

Hatch has significantly expanded Skyline's reach and impact, providing access to academic and wellbeing resources through a scalable digital hub and interactive live events. In 2023, Skyline Hatch introduced the HatchHUB web portal to improve the accessibility of Hatch resources, addressing student requests for convenient access to pre-recorded content for self-paced learning and revision anywhere, anytime. Hatch offers VCAA curriculum aligned SAC Preparation and VCE Hack (Study Skills) online modules, along with recordings and resources from our live online masterclasses, including our flagship Exam Revision Series.

Throughout the year, Hatch measures key impact metrics focusing on session usefulness, uplift in student confidence, and reduction in feelings of stress about VCE and exams. The feedback from participants underscores the value of Hatch programs in helping students navigate their final years of high school with confidence and success.

I am thrilled to present Skyline's Annual Report reflecting on the impactful journey we embarked on in 2023. In the current economic environment, we faced various challenges, including increasing costs due to inflationary conditions and a reduction in investment income. Our financial stability remains robust, with thanks to the generosity of our donors and partners. However, the economic challenges presented by the current environment underscore the importance of diversifying our funding sources and ensuring prudent financial management.

#### **OUR IMPACT**

In 2023, we achieved significant impact, with our Skyline Program supporting 160 students from over 40 schools. 50% of our students came from rural and regional areas where the greatest inequity in access to educational resourcing is experienced. This reflects our commitment to reaching more high potential students and providing them with the support they need to succeed.

#### SKYLINE HATCH

Our Skyline Hatch social enterprise program reached over 4,000 students across Victoria, providing invaluable support and resources to VCE students statewide. This achievement underscores our dedication to making a meaningful impact on the educational landscape of Victoria and beyond.

We are delighted to welcome the Department of Education for the first time in supporting our VCE Hack program, delivered by Skyline Hatch. This partnership represents a significant milestone in our efforts to expand our reach and provide innovative educational opportunities to young individuals across the state.

## **2023 EVALUATION**

Our 2023 evaluation revealed some promising insights:

- 45% of Year 12 graduates achieved ATARs of 80 or above, marking the highest 'top end' achievement since 2018.
- 93% of students acknowledged that the program provided them with opportunities to build confidence.
- 89% of students expressed increased confidence in realising their potential due to their involvement in Skyline.
- 85% of students highlighted the program's significant positive impact on their VCE experience.

#### **EVENTS**

The Residential Program at Queen's College, University of Melbourne, provided a vital sense of community and academic support for both our new Year 11 cohort and Year 12 students. ## SKYLINE PROGRAM

OUR FOCUS IS ON HIGH ABILITY STUDENTS WHO DISPLAY A GROWTH MINDSET, LEADERSHIP POTENTIAL, AND RESILIENCE IN THE FACE OF THEIR SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC CHALLENGES, TO FIND PATHWAYS TO FURTHER STUDY AND EMPLOYMENT. WE IDENTIFY THE EDUCATIONAL CHANGES NEEDED TO SUPPORT OUR STUDENTS IN ACHIEVING THEIR POTENTIAL AND FULL FILL LING THEIR DREAMS THROUGH EDUCATION.

#### **SKYLINE PROGRAM 2023**

The Skyline Program offers a comprehensive support system for students throughout their two years of VCE by investing in key areas, such as mentoring and community-building, financial support, personal, academic and career development and complementary partnerships. These focus areas are vital for equipping students with the best chance of success at school – and in life. Throughout 2023, we supported 160 Year 11 and 12 students from 40 partner schools across Victoria. Across the year we held our key events for each year level, including a Residential and three Masterclasses.

#### TRANSFORMATIVE LEARNING EXPERIENCES

Each year students attend unique Skyline-designed Residential in January and one-day Masterclasses during school holiday to develop and grow students' personal and academic capabilities. A highlight of these events is community-building and employing Skyline Alumni as mentors. Close to 40 Alumni were engaged across various Skyline events, providing strong role models within the community.

This year's Residential was held in January at University of Melbourne's Queen's College and focused on the themes of 'Who am I?' for Year 11 students and 'Who do I want to be?' for Year 12 students. Residential was a launching pad for Year 11 Skyliners to develop their sense of identity and community in relation to the Skyline Program, understand where their values and beliefs come from and how these elements of their identity can change over time. They also gained practical knowledge and skills in the areas of VCE, wellbeing and confidence. Year 12 Skyliners reconnected and continued to build a strong sense of community with one another. They revised goals they had set at the end of the previous year, navigated potential challenges to reaching their goals and mapped out what they would like their futures to encompass.

April Masterclass was generously hosted by the National Gallery of Victoria (NGV) in collaboration with NGV Educators. Students explored the Melbourne Now and Top Arts exhibitions, including an exclusive artist talk from Jevans Wang at the NGVA. Skyliners were delighted to tour local art and design which celebrated different mediums including fashion, jewellery, painting, sculpture, ceramics, video, performance and publishing In collaboration with RMIT's Schools Network. In collaboration with RMIT's Schools Network Access Program (SNAP), students had the opportunity to explore university life and courses, develop and cement their post Year 12 pathways and gain an in depth understanding of the VTAC, SEAS and Scholarships process. Finally, the September Masterclass, delivered in collaboration with Victoria University, rounded off a year of impactful Skyline events. The focus was on setting up for success heading into Year 12 and VCE

Skyline Program Managers, Jigna Desai and Sarah Segal, set up the committee to gain input and seek feedback from a diverse range of Skyline students and alumni on all facets of the Skyline Program through a series of quarterly meetings. The inaugural PDAC's membership consisted of four Skyline alumni, three Year 12 students and three Year 11 students. It gave the Skyline Program Managers a chance to work alongside students and alumni, learn from their brilliant ideas, provide them with a leadership opportunity and make the program more student-centred while striving for continuous improvement.

The Skyline Program has been an absolute blessing to be a part of. My favourite memory from the program were the residential camps once a year. They were the best experience I could've asked for when deciding to go to the University of Melbourne. Our mentors made sure we had the best time possible, and everyone become so close in the short time we had together. The activities helped us grow our connections to each other and the program, further enabling us to feel supported in our futures. Skyline helped make my final year more enjoyable than I expected. Getting the opportunity to spend a couple days with my Skyline family every term holidays helped alleviate some of the stress associated with year 12, and the academic support they provided in term 3 and 4 really helped me prepare for my exams and change my perspective on them – they're not as life altering as some may lead you to believe.

Every month Skyline would check in, encouraging me to check in on myself. I was able to make sure I was taking care of myself – particularly my mental health, as well as keeping up with study. When it came to preparing for my end of year exams Skyline was right there with me. If I didn't access Hatch in year-12 I wouldn't have been as prepared for exams as I was. I took part in the exam revision, and it gave me a good place to start in exam prep. It reminded me of key topics, helped me understand concepts I previously found confusing and built faith in myself. It also helped me connect with some amazing people, network and improve my mental health by reducing my stress through social interaction and study tips.

My favourite memory of Skyline is from the 2023 Year 12 Residential, all my friends and I hanging out and playing uno in one of our rooms. We couldn't control our laughter. It's not like we were laughing at anything in particular – except our friends absolutely fantastical dancing to Brittany Spears – it was that every little motion or smirk made us crack up. The connections you make at Skyline are like no other, you find your family here. Through the Skyline masterclasses I built the relationships I have today, and I wouldn't trade them for the world. The academic and financial support was grand, but the friendships you make are forever cherished. I was able to visit a number of universities and take part in mock classes at these masterclasses. Thanks to Skyline, I was able to get a taste of design and science, my two interests at the time.

The experiences I had made me realise I would enjoy a design course more than a science course during my time at Uni, and so it lead me to completing a Bachelor of Design at Monash this year. I am forever thankful to Skyline, and I hope more students get to experience the same support and love that I got from them."

I am a 2023 Skyline graduate and currently in my first year of an Advanced Diploma of Engineering Technology (Civil Engineering Design) at RMIT. Looking back one year ago, I can now see I didn't have the best time in Year 12. Often, I felt the Skyline Residential and Masterclasses were the only things that I had to look forward to.

What Skyline provides is something that you can only truly understand when you become a part of it. Yes, it is a foundation that provides students with financial help and support during their two years of VCE. However, Skyline also opens up opportunities to grow as an individual in this world, make lifelong friends and teach you that if one door closes another one opens. And if that door also closes, the Skyline community will help you find or create a new door. It is important to know Skyline is a program that if you are willing, will help you no matter what.

I never thought I would be accepted into the Skyline Program, but I am grateful that I was. The unique Masterclasses, on top of being a time to catch up and have fun with friends, provided me with life lessons for now and for the future. I found the information regarding how to navigate Year 12 and the process for transitioning to university life, as well as the exposure to universities and residential colleges, very helpful.

Tutoring is a big factor for a VCE student, and the beautiful thing about Skyline Hatch is that it employs Skyline alumni as tutors. This means that they know what it is like to sit on the other side of the laptop screen, and the most important part is that they enjoy teaching students. I know this because one of my close friends joined Skyline Hatch as a tutor and shared with me how much he loves it.

The friends that I made from Skyline are irreplaceable; they are like family to me. I can't quite explain it, but there is a unique connection between us, even though we only saw each other five or six times a year during our time in the Skyline Program. When we came together for Skyline events, we behaved as if we all went to the same school and were simply meeting up for a field trip. When I became a mentor for the 2024 Residential, I was able to see the same friendships and joy that I experienced reflected in the current cohorts.

People ask me what Skyline is and why am I so fixated on it. It is simply because Skyline believed in me when I didn't believe in myself. No matter what you choose, whatever it is, just remember Skyline will always be there for you.

I deeply cherish the mentors in my life. It has been both relieving and motivating to connect with and learn from women, especially those from disenfranchised backgrounds. My mentors have shown me that success is attainable and that I am worth the work I put into myself. Aside from invaluable advice on how to navigate my career journey, education and personal development, mentoring offered me a safe environment to inquire and gain insight through the wisdom of those I look up to. Thanks to my mentors, I know that it's okay to struggle and that no matter which point I may start from, my dreams are valid and attainable.

## MY JOURNEY THROUGH HIGH SCHOOL

I adored studying French and Chemistry in high school because the former satisfied my fondness for communication, and the latter satisfied my love for understanding how things work. Regarding French, I think it's one of the coolest things in the world to be able to convey ideas and connect with people through a different system of sounds and symbols. I learnt ways of seeing the world through a different lens. As for Chemistry, nothing felt more gratifying in Chem class than having one of those light bulb moments where a concept finally clicks.

School, especially the final two years, can be immensely difficult and demanding, especially since it occurred during a pivotal time in my life during which I was figuring out my identity and facing the intimidation which came with deciding on what to do after high school. I deeply regret neglecting activities which in fact enriched my brain and rejuvenated me under the excuse of "not having enough time".

## MY ROLE AS A MENTOR

As a mentor of many past Skyline experiences, such as the Annual Residential Experience and NGV Masterclass, I've been afforded the opportunity to learn about the lives of young adults navigating modern obstacles in an everchanging world and play a part in cultivating the next generation of changemakers, leaders and activists.
